Overview

StreamPump transmits MPEG1 and MPEG2 files via multicast or Unicast sessions on Windows desktops. It operates under Windows 2000 and Windows XP.

Installation Instructions

Install StreamPump by running SetupStreamPump.exe and following the directions. There is no key or license file required to install and use StreamPump.

The StreamPump setup application installs files in the default target folder:

C:\Program Files\VBrick\StreamPump

The software can be launched by opening up the StreamPump.exe located in this directory or by going to:

Start, Programs or Program Files, VBrick, StreamPump

Enhancements – Release 2.1.0

- Several enhancements have been made to handle imperfect MPEG files.
- StreamPump no longer requires a key to install.

Caveats

For high bit rate batch files, the transition from one file to another may have some delay and video may break up.
